2022 International Students Admission of CAUC

I. Introduction to CAUC

Civil Aviation University of China (CAUC), under the direct administration of Civil Aviation Administration of China (CAAC), is a higher education institution aiming to train students into senior engineering technicians and management personnel. It was co-established by Civil Aviation Administration of China, Tianjin Municipal Government, and Ministry of Education in 1951.

Back in September 1951, CAUC was founded as No.2 Civil Aviation School that was administered directly by the Civil Aviation Administration of Central Military Commission of China, with the first president Fang Huai appointed by Chairman Mao Zedong and the location chosen by former Premier Zhou Enlai. No.2 Civil Aviation School was renamed as Civil Aviation College of China in 1981, and adopted the current name Civil Aviation University of China on May 30th, 2006. With a total area of 1.694 million m² and a building area of 874 thousand m², CAUC now has one campus in Dongli District of Tianjin, one campus in Ninghe District of Tianjin under construction and three flight training colleges Chaoyang Flight Training College, Inner Mongolia Training College and Xinjiang Tianxiang Aviation College. After 70 years of pursuing excellence, CAUC has evolved into the main base and major force of training civil aviation technicians and promoting scientific and technological

V. Application for Admission

1. Applicant Eligibility

(1) Applicants of bachelor degree programs should hold a high school graduation certificate and transcript; Applicants of master degree programs should hold a bachelor degree certificate and transcript.

(2) Applicants of Chinese-taught programs should get a mark of 180 or higher in HSK 4, or have an equivalent Chinese proficiency level; Applicants of English-taught programs should be good at English listening, speaking, reading and writing.

(3) Applicants of Chinese-taught bachelor degree programs should already complete a one-year preparatory education in China before registration at CAUC.

(4) Be in good health and have no criminal record.

3. Application and Admission Procedure

(1) Log on cauc.at0086.cn/student and create an account.

(2) Fill out your personal information, upload the scanned copy of supporting documents, pay the application fee, upload the payment proof, submit the application, and wait for the review.

Period for Application: February 1st, 2022-May 31st, 2022

(3) The accepted applicants will receive a scanned copy of Admission Letter via the application website or email before August 2022.

(4) Download the WeChat app and create an account.

(5) Join the WeChat group chat by following the instruction on the Admission Notice and wait for further notice about online/offline registration.


(6) Undergo the qualification review before registration. Those who fail the qualification review will be ineligible for registration.

(7) The semester will begin in September 2022. Please wait for further notice about the exact date.
